



## Configuring InScribe for edX

Setting up InScribe within edX is a multi part process: sharing a key/secret and configuring edX for LTI generally (for more info see: [edX LTI setup docs](#), and configuring each LTI location/item.

### Get Your Secret and Key

Contact the InScribe team to get (or share) a secret and a key identifier for usage during the edX Tool Provider setup process. To request or share a secret and key - please email us at [support@inscribeapp.com](mailto:support@inscribeapp.com).

*Note - We will share the actual secret via a separate secure mechanism.*

### Configure edX for LTI

Step 1 - Within Settings -> Advanced Settings:

1. First, ensure that "lti\_consumer" is in the Advanced Module List.

2. Add InScribe as an LTI tool in "LTI Passports" e.g.

## Allow username and email

InScribe needs the LTI tool setup so that "Request user's email" and "Request user's username" settings show up in the LTI Consumer edit screens so they can be set to True. We use these values to provision/identify users when they launch InScribe and to send notifications via email (which can be opted out of). We do not share this (or any) information outside of InScribe.

By default, these settings which will show when adding an LTI item, are not available in Studio.

## Adding Links to InScribe from edX

There are two types of links that you can create from your edX courses.

### 1. Embedded Homepage

The Embedded Homepage launches a specialized view of InScribe that loads in an iFrame within the edX experience. When launching an embedded view, you have the option to “pre-filter” the content that the user will see by:

- Channel
- Topic
- Channel + Topic

### 2. Link to InScribe in a Second Tab

Linking out to InScribe launches a new tab in the user’s browser. When linking out, you have several options for where the user lands initially within InScribe:

- Homepage
- Topic Page
- Specific Channel
- Specific Channel, pre-filtered to a specific topic
- Specific Conversation or Resource

## InScribe Custom Parameters

When adding links to InScribe, you will be asked to provide certain custom parameters depending on the type of link and whether you want to pre-filter the user’s view. Here is a list of the custom parameters and where to find them:

| Custom Parameter      | What it is   | Where to find it   |
|-----------------------|--|--|
| inscribe_community_id | The unique identifier for your community in InScribe.              | Your community id in the 16 digit number located in the URL when you are in your community in InScribe. In the example below - the inscribe_community_id is <b>1111222233334444</b><br><br><a href="https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444">https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444</a>                                   |
| inscribe_channel      | The identifier for a specific channel (aka sub-group) in InScribe. | The channel id appears in the InScribe url (just after the community id) when you are in a specific channel. In the example below, your inscribe_channel is <b>fall-2019-cohort</b><br><br><a href="https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/fall-2019-cohort">https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/fall-2019-cohort</a> |

| inscribe_category_code | The unique identifier for a topic.   | The category code appears in the InScribe url when you are viewing a particular topic area. It is referred to as the “topic-slug”. In the example below, your inscribe_category_code is <b>introduce+yourself</b><br><br><a href="https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/questions?topicSlug=introduce+yourself">https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/questions?topicSlug=introduce+yourself</a> |
| resource_type          | Specifies whether the resource is a conversation or an item from the resources area. | If you are linking to a specific conversation, the resource_type is <b>questions</b> .<br><br>If you are linking to a specific resource, the resource_type is <b>compositions</b> .  |
| resource_id            | Unique identifier for a conversation or resource in InScribe.                        | The resource id is a 16 digit number and can be found in the InScribe URL when viewing a specific conversation or resource. In the example below, the resource_id is <b>0000999988887777</b> .<br><br><a href="https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/questions/0000999988887777">https://inscribe.education/main/inscribe/1111222233334444/questions/0000999988887777</a>  |

## Adding the “Embedded Community Homepage”

1. Using “Add New Component”, select Advanced, then LTI Consumer. This will add an LTI Consumer to that location, which then needs to be Edited.
2. Click “Edit”.
